



J. Dewey Soper Award Nomination Form

The J. Dewey Soper Award is given periodically by Alberta Society of Professional Biologists (ASPB) to a Canadian Biologist who has made significant contributions to the field of biology. Awarded in memory of Dr. J. Dewey Soper, 1893-1982, who was highly regarded for his role in the development of biology in western and northern Canada. He wrote the original *Mammals of Alberta*, served as Chief Migratory Bird Officer of western and northern Canada from 1934-1952, and undertook extensive natural history studies throughout Alberta as an Emeritus Professor of the University of Alberta. Recipients of Soper Award have included Dr. Stu Smith, Dr. Ian McTaggart-Cowan, Richard Fyfe, Dr. Valerius Geist, Dr. Stephen Herrero, Dr. Charley Bird, Dr. Geoff Holroyd, Dr. Joe Nelson, Dr. Ian Stirling, Dr. Joyce Gould, and Peter Sherrington.

Nominations can be submitted by any ASPB member. The Board of Directors reviews nominations and selects recipient.
