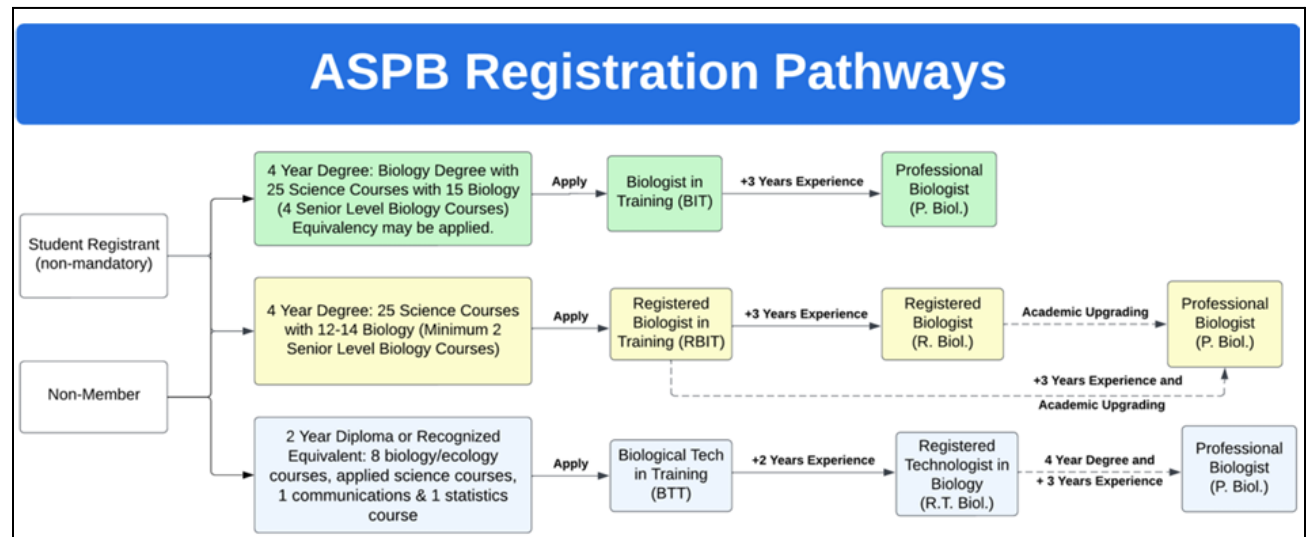
### Become a Student Member
